Summer Library Programs Help to fill Summer Learning Gaps

Research shows that while gaps in student achievement remain relatively constant during the school year, the gaps widen significantly during the summer. These losses add up over time. If we are not intentional about early literacy in the summer, by 5th grade, this gap can leave students 2 ½ - 3 years behind their peers. As little as twenty minutes of cognitive engagement per day is enough to prevent this loss from happening. And as always, Schreiner Memorial Library is here to help!
